A native of Cleveland, Ohio, Jon has an undergraduate degree from Georgetown University and a MBA from Northwestern University. He moved to Colorado Springs in 1974 to work in marketing at Current Inc. In 1987 he became president/CEO of Current. In 1996, he was named president/CEO of the Walter Drake company. When he and his investors sold that business in 2003, he orchestrated the purchase of Chef's Catalog from Neiman Marcus in 2004 and oversaw its move to Colorado Springs in 2005. Still a member of Chef's Board of Directors, Medved retired from its day-to-day activities in November 2006.

Medved is a former board chair of Goodwill.
