- CRA is located in Sierra High School
- We offer alternative education opportunities to at risk youth
 - Referred from Sierra, Harrison, or out of district
- Started in 2013-14 graduated 23 students
- 2014-15 moved to Sierra campus and graduated 16, this year similar or better!
- Half days in OMI (online monitored instruction) and half of day in vocational classes
 - Cosmetology, automotive, construction
- Intellitec \$15,000 scholarship
- Skills USA Competition
- AutoBowl Competition

CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM

- Began this 2015-16 year
- We are the first program in the Colorado Springs area
- Supported by the Housing and Builders Association of Colorado Springs and Associated General Contractors Association of Colorado
- Adopted and adapted the Housing and Builders Institute (HBI) secondary education curriculum

SKILLS IN THE CLASSROOM

- We have introduced OSHA concepts of safety
- Skills such as tool identification and safe power and hand tool use
 - Use of trowels and chop saws in masonry, taping knives in sheet rock, speed squares and circular saws in carpentry and conduit benders in electrical
- We promote construction as a professional career by using current articles about employment, housing statistics, aging work force and history
- In that process we talk about appropriate attire, vocabulary, tattoos, tools and respect

Projects...

- We have constructed things like mini sidewalks, interior and exterior walls, shed roofs, residential wiring and even some conduit bending
- Our hope is to work with Habitat for Humanity in the future
