Purpose



- Ensure consistent language, terminology, and formatting
- Update rules and procedures to mirror current Council practices
- Remove outdated and obsolete rules and procedures
- Address Council requested rule changes
- Last comprehensive revision was completed in 2013

Previous Council Action



- In 2011, Rules and Procedures were revised to reflect change in form of government
- Current Rules and Procedures Adopted
 - Resolution No. 42-13
- Amendments
 - Resolution No. 8-14 (Procedures for Confirmation of Mayoral Appointees)
 - Resolution No. 83-16 (Removal of Donations and Unspent Funds)
 - Resolution No. 3-20 (Repeal of Part 6 – Land Acquisitions)

Virtual Meetings



- Per Resolution No. 114-20, certain Rules and Procedures are suspended to allow for electronic participation of Councilmembers at Council Meetings, Quasi-Judicial Hearings, and Closed Executive Sessions
- Permanent changes to Rules and Procedures would need to occur to facilitate future electronic participation
