AS NATIONAL PUBLIC HEALTH WEEK

WHEREAS, the vision of El Paso County Public Health is for all El Paso County residents to live in thriving communities where every person has the opportunity to achieve optimal health; and


WHEREAS, El Paso County Public Health promotes resiliency, community connectedness, and health to assure the well-being of all our populations and communities; and
