The site development plan is as follows (from Section 1.2 of the Engineering Design and Operations Plan):

The Stericycle Colorado Springs facility is a staffed facility that temporarily stores and transfers regulated medical waste (RMW), Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) waste (regulated garbage), and non-hazardous pharmaceutical waste. Transfers are conducted in a truck-to-truck manner from smaller route trucks to larger transfer trailers under supervision of trained personnel. These transfers may occur either directly between the two trucks or via loading dock(s). RMW and APHIS wastes transferred at the Facility are typically transported to the Stericycle Dacono autoclave steam sterilization facility for treatment prior to eventual disposal. The Colorado Springs facility operates up to 52 weeks a year, 7 days a week, 24 hours a day, as needed, to manage and process incoming medical waste. Normal business hours are 5:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
