## LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

COMMENCING at the intersection of the Northwesterly extension of the Southwesterly right-of-way line of Grand Vista Circle as dedicated in Grand Vista Filing No. 1 recorded in Plat Book H-6 at Page 42 of the records of said El Paso County, the following five (5) courses are on the Southwesterly right-of-way line of said Grand Vista Circle; thence: 1) S50.35'12"E a distance of 135.75 feet to a point of curve; 2) on a curve to the left having a central angle of $24^{\circ} 43^{\prime} 26^{\prime \prime}$, a radius of 330.00 feet for an arc distance of 142.40 feet, whose chord bears $S 62^{\circ} 56^{\prime} 55^{\prime \prime} E$ to a point of reverse curve; 3 ) on a curve to the right having a central angle of $2756^{\prime} 19^{\prime \prime}$, a radius of 270.00 feet for an arc distance of 131.66 feet, whose chord bears $S 61^{\prime} 20^{\prime} 29^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$; 4) S4T22' $19^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$ a distance of 73.03 feet to a point of curve; 5) on a curve to the left having a central angle of $25^{\circ} 59^{\prime} 47^{\prime \prime}$, a radius of 305.00 feet for an arc distance of 138.39 feet, whose chord bears S60 22' $13^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$ to the POINT OF BEGINNING, the following three (3) courses are on the Southerly and Southeasterly right-of-way line of said Grand Vista Circle; thence: 1) on a curve to the left having a central angle of $56{ }^{\circ} 53^{\prime} 06^{\prime \prime}$, a radius of 305.00 feet for an arc distance of 302.81 feet, whose chord bears $N 78^{\circ} 11^{\prime} 21^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$; 2) $\mathrm{N} 49^{\circ} 44^{\prime} 48^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$ a distance of 300.94 feet to a point of curve; 3) on a curve to the left having a central angle of $23^{\prime \prime} 09^{\prime} 51^{\prime \prime}$, a radius of 330.00 feet for an arc distance of 133.42 feet, whose chord bears $\mathrm{N} 38^{\circ} 09^{\circ} 53^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$; thence S40'15'12"E a distance of 436.22 feet; thence S49 $44^{\prime} 48^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ a distance of 733.24 feet to the most Northerly comer of the tract of land described in Book 6496 at Page 989 of the records of said El Paso County; thence $N 48^{\circ} 32^{\prime} 38^{\circ} \mathrm{W}$ a distance of 484.71 feet; thence N19*26'23"E a distance of 135.43 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 7.713 acres of land, more or less.
