
Request

- City Council to authorize the disposal of surplus City property in accordance with City Charter § 1-20
 - Proposed property is approximately 100 acres
 - Airport receiving Fair Market Value
 - Disposal of property will open up approximately 200 acres of additional developable land with expansion of infrastructure
 - Contingent upon Federal Aviation Administration's land release
