Redrawing the Boundaries

- City Charter Requires the City Clerk redraw the boundaries
 - City Charter Article II. Elective Officers
 - 2-10(b) Districts
- At least 120 days but no more than 150 days prior to a preliminary district election
- Every Four (4) years

The City Clerk Process

- Release a preliminary district report
- Conduct a public hearing on the preliminary district report
- Prepare a final district report on the setting the district boundaries

District Requirements

- Districts Must be:
 - Substantially equal in population
 - Contiguous
 - Comply with Voting Rights Act and other pertinent laws
- Plan does NOT have to be approved by the Mayor or City Council

Districting Process Advisory Committee (City Council Appointed)

- Role
 - Oversee the public process
 - Educate the public
 - Assist the City Clerk
 - Advise City Council on the districting process
- City Code Section 5.1.401 through 5.1.408



Districting Process Advisory Committee Selection Process

- City Council Appoints Seven Committee Members
- One member from each district and one member at-large

Districting Process Advisory Committee Selection Process

- Members must be registered electors of the City
- Council must strive for gender, racial, ethnic, age and geographic diversity of the committee members
- A person interested in being a candidate for a district council member shall not serve on the committee.

Responsibilities of the Advisory Committee

- Conduct one public meeting in each of the six election districts to solicit input for the City Clerk
- Prepare a preliminary Advisory Committee Report and submit to the City Clerk and City Council
- Prepare a final Advisory Committee report and submit to City Council after the City Clerk releases the final district report
