AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 701 (DEFINITIONS) AND 702 (LICENSE REQUIRED; FEE; TERM) OF PART 7 (PEDDLERS OF FOOD WARES) OF ARTICLE 3 (SALES OF GOODS AND SERVICES) OF CHAPTER 2 (BUSINESS LICENSING, LIQUOR REGULATION AND TAXATION) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO FOOD PEDDLER LICENSES

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Section 701 (Definitions) of Part 7 (Peddlers of Food Wares) of Article 3 (Sales of Goods and Services) of Chapter 2 (Business Licensing, Liquor Regulation and Taxation) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.3.701: DEFINITIONS:

EXEMPTIONS: All religious, nonprofit and charitable organizations are exempt from peddler licensing requirements.

PEDDLING: The selling, offering for sale, distribution, or offering for distribution of foodstuffs food wares from place to place or on public ways or public property whether by crying food wares, hawking, soliciting orders or otherwise, and shall include the selling, offering for sale, distribution or offering for distribution from a peddler's cart or from baskets or containers taken from place to place within the City, other than delivery from regularly established, permanent business locations.

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Section 2. Section 702 (License Required; Fee; Term) of Part 7 (Peddlers of Food Wares) of Article 3 (Sales of Goods and Services) of Chapter 2 (Business Licensing, Liquor Regulation and Taxation) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.3.702: LICENSE REQUIRED; FEE**S**; TERM; **EXEMPTION**:

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person to peddle foodstuffs food wares within the City without first obtaining a license. The license fFees for peddling foodstuffs food wares shall be as established by the City Council under article 1, part 5 of this chapter, and the license shall expire on December 31 of each one year from the date of issuance, unless suspended or revoked earlier.
- B. All religious, nonprofit, and charitable organizations are exempt from the requirements of this section.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of January 1, 2015, and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 4. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance shall be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
