

ORDINANCE NO. 17-_____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 16-116 (2017 APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE) FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE LODGERS & AUTO RENTAL TAX (LART) FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$235,642 FOR EVENTS RECOMMENDED BY THE LART CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 16-116 is hereby amended by increasing the expenditure appropriation of the Lodgers & Auto Rental Tax (LART) Fund in the amount of \$235,642 for the following LART events. The source of funds is the LART available fund balance.

- Haute Route Rockies \$50,000 *
- Pridefest \$10,000
- El Pomar Youth Sports \$17,000
- Cultural Office of the Pikes Peak Region (COPPeR) \$142,000
- KRCC Radio-Blues Under the Bridge \$5,000 *
- Fallen Firefighter Memorial \$11,642 *

*These three (3) items were originally budgeted in 2016; however, invoices were not received prior to the close of the 2016 books. Therefore, these funds returned to the LART fund balance. These organizations/events reapplied for the 2016 funding through the recently completed off-cycle request process.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance shall be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
