

ORDINANCE NO. 22 - 33

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 20-44  
REVISING THE NAME OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT  
TRANSPARENCY AND ACCOUNTABILITY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, on July 14, 2020, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 20-44, establishing the Law Enforcement Transparency and Accountability Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement Transparency and Accountability Commission (LETAC) recommends that City Council revise Ordinance No. 20-44 to change the name of the Commission to the Law Enforcement Transparency Advisory Commission to better align with the work of the Commission.

Section 1. Ordinance No. 20-44 is amended as follows:


