

ORDINANCE NO. 14-_____

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING SECTION 1006 (BOARD CREATED; APPOINTMENTS) OF PART 10 (PUBLIC SAFETY SALES AND USE TAX FUND) OF ARTICLE 6 (CITY FUNDS) OF CHAPTER 1 (ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL, AND FINANCE) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO THE COMPOSITION OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY SALES TAX OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Sales Tax Oversight Committee (PSSTOC) is composed of a total of eleven (11) appointed members who are residents of specific City Council districts, as well as at-large members; and

WHEREAS, City Council finds that the PSSTOC member appointments should reflect the increase in the number of City Council Districts from four (4) to six (6) so that each Council District is represented on the PSSTOC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Section 1006 (Board Created; Appointments) of Part 10 (Public Safety Sales and Use Tax Fund) of Article 6 (City Funds) of Chapter 1 (Administration, Personnel, and Finance) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

1.6.1006: Board Created; Appointments:

A. There is hereby created the Public Safety Sales Tax Oversight Committee, to be composed of eleven (11) members selected and appointed by City Council. Of these eleven (11) members, one member shall represent each of the **six (6)** ~~four (4)~~ City Council districts of the City and **five (5)** ~~seven (7)~~ shall be at large members. For the calendar year 2002, four (4) at large members shall be drawn from the leadership and membership of the SCIP01 Citizens Coordination Committee, the Public Safety Subcommittee and the Public Safety Executive Committee. All members shall be residents of the City during their terms, **and each member appointed to represent City Council district shall be a resident of the district the member is appointed to represent during the member's term.**

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
