AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 105 (CANDIDATES FOR ELECTION) OF PART 1 (EMPLOYEE RULES AND REGULATIONS) OF ARTICLE 4 (CITY EMPLOYEES) OF CHAPTER 1 (ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL AND FINANCE) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO CANDIDATES FOR ELECTION

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Section 105 (Candidates For Election) of Part 1 (Employee Rules and Regulations) of Article 4 (City Employees) of Chapter 1 (Administration, Personnel and Finance) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

1.4.105: CANDIDATES FOR ELECTION:

Any officer appointed by the Mayor or City Council (excluding members of boards and commissions), or any appointed department director or manager of the City who files an acceptance of petition for nomination as a candidate for any elective office of the State of Colorado, the County of El Paso, the City or any school district lying wholly or partly within the City limits or within the service area of the Utilities, shall immediately cease holding office or employment with the City unless first having obtained the consent of the Mayor, **or a majority of City Council** ~~or the respective Council appointee~~, **as appropriate**.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
