ORDINANCE NO. 22 - 59

AN ORDINANCE DECLINING THE PARTICIPATION OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS IN THE COLORADO PAID FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE INSURANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Colorado voters approved Proposition 118 in November 2020 creating a state-run Paid Family and Medical Leave Insurance ("FAMLI") program; and

WHEREAS, Section 8-13.3-522, Colorado Revised Statutes ("C.R.S."), allows local governments to decline to participate in the FAMLI program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Colorado Springs wishes to decline to participate in the FAMLI program at this time, which declination of participation must be reconsidered at least every 8 years; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 8-13.3-514 allows employees of local governments that decline participation to voluntarily elect coverage under the FAMLI program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. That the City of Colorado Springs, a home rule city and Colorado

municipal corporation, hereby declines to participate in the Colorado FAMLI program

pursuant to C.R.S. § 8-13.3-522.

Section 2. That this declination of participation shall apply to the City of Colorado Springs, all its municipal enterprises and the Colorado Springs Utilities enterprise.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 4. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
