

**PETITION TO THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS, COLORADO,
TO AMEND THE CONSOLIDATED SERVICE PLAN FOR COLORADO CROSSING
METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NOS. 1, 2, AND 3**

WHEREAS, the Colorado Crossing Metropolitan District Nos 1, 2, and 3 (collectively, the “**District**”), were organized under a consolidated service plan approved by the City Council of the City of Colorado Springs, Colorado (the “**City**”) on August 22, 2006 (the “**Consolidated Service Plan**”); and

WHEREAS, the City passed Resolution No. 126-06 approving the Consolidated Service Plan; and

WHEREAS, the District submitted the First Amendment to the Consolidated Service Plan of Colorado Crossing Metropolitan District Nos. 1, 2, and 3 which was approved by the City through Resolution 16-530 on October 25, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the District submitted the Second Amendment to the Consolidated Service Plan of Colorado Crossing Metropolitan District Nos. 1, 2 and 3 which was approved by the City through Resolution 157-18 on December 11, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the District submitted the Third Amendment to the Consolidated Service Plan of Colorado Crossing Metropolitan District Nos. 1, 2 and 3 which was approved by the City through Resolution 105-20 on November 10, 2020; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to § 32-1-204.7(1), C.R.S., the District desires to have the City consider approval of a Fourth Amendment to the Consolidated Service Plan for the District (“**Fourth Amendment**”), which Fourth Amendment will recognize increased Public Improvement Costs and an increased maximum Debt issuance limitation as a result of increased costs in providing public infrastructure within the Service Area of the Districts and will authorize the imposition of special assessments within the Service Area of the Districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Colorado Crossing Metropolitan District Nos. 1, 2, and 3 hereby petition the City of Colorado Springs, Colorado, to approve the Fourth Amendment to the Consolidated Service Plan pursuant to § 32-1-207, C.R.S., and all applicable provisions of the Colorado Springs Municipal Code.
