

ORDINANCE NO. 17-88

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 109 (UNLAWFUL ACTS) OF PART 1 (MEDICAL MARIJUANA LICENSE CODE) OF ARTICLE 2 (MARIJUANA) OF CHAPTER 2 (BUSINESS LICENSING, LIQUOR REGULATION AND TAXATION) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO MEDICAL MARIJUANA CENTER HOURS OF OPERATION

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Section 109 (Unlawful Acts) of Part 1 (Medical Marijuana License Code) of Article 2 (Marijuana) of Chapter 2 (Business Licensing, Liquor Regulation and Taxation) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

2.2.109: UNLAWFUL ACTS:

A: \* \* \*

13. Sell, serve, or distribute any Medical Marijuana or Medical Marijuana Infused Product at any time other than between the hours of 8:00 am and ~~7:00~~ **9:00** pm, Monday through Sunday.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this

ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
