- Updates proposed to Motor Vehicles and Traffic Code
 - Revisions independent from share mobility programs
 - Conformance and realignment with state statues
 - Integrates new mobility devices into traffic regulation and control
 - New definitions
 - Bike infrastructure types
 - Electrical assisted bicycles
 - Electric personal assistive mobility devices (EPAMD)
 - Scooters
 - Toy vehicles
 - Vehicle(s)

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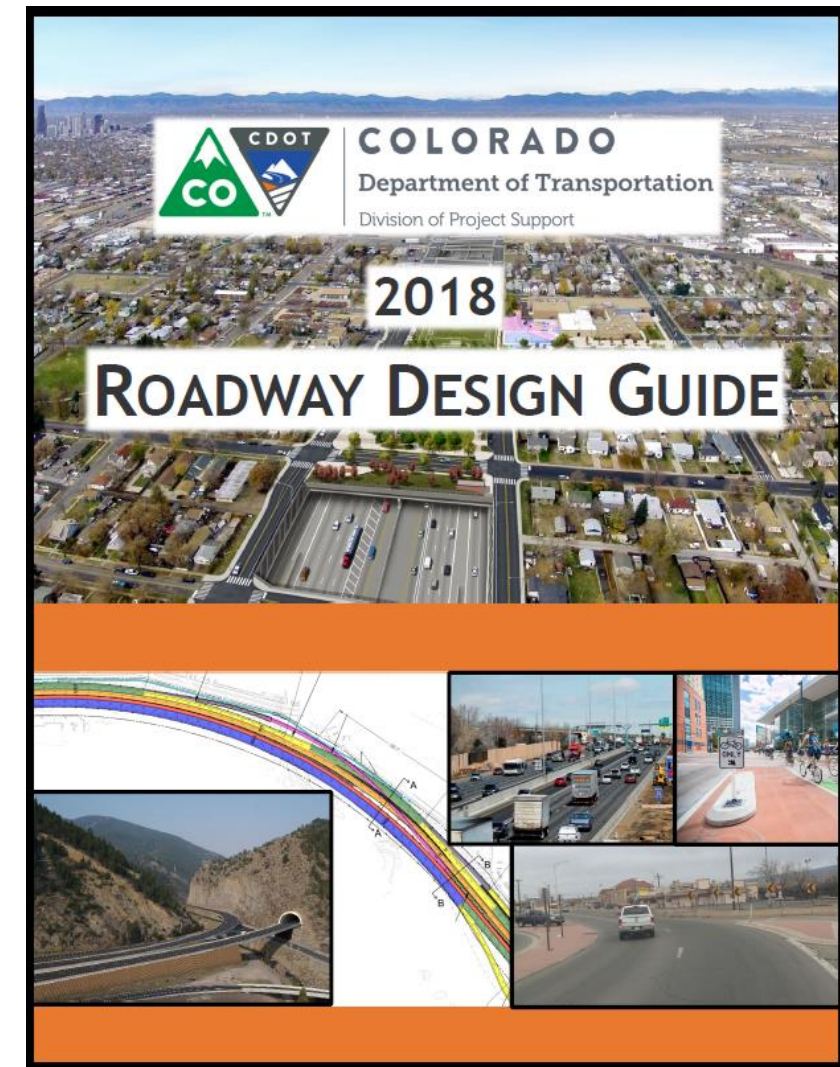
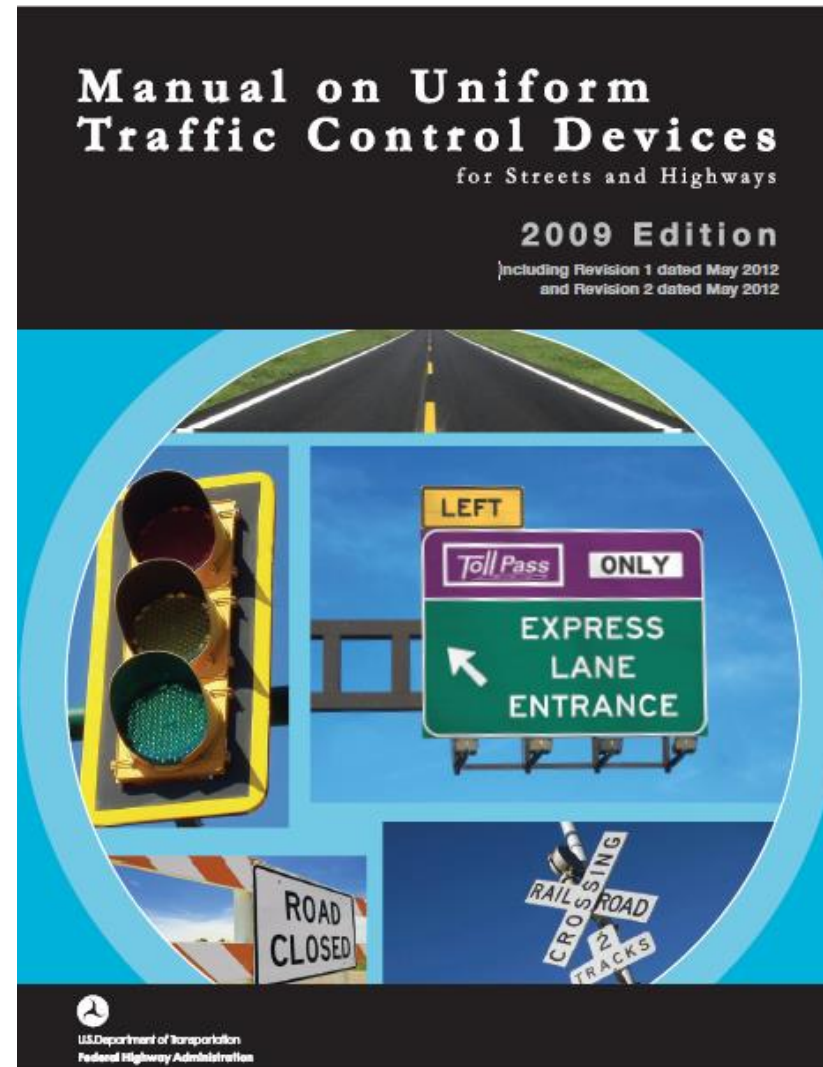
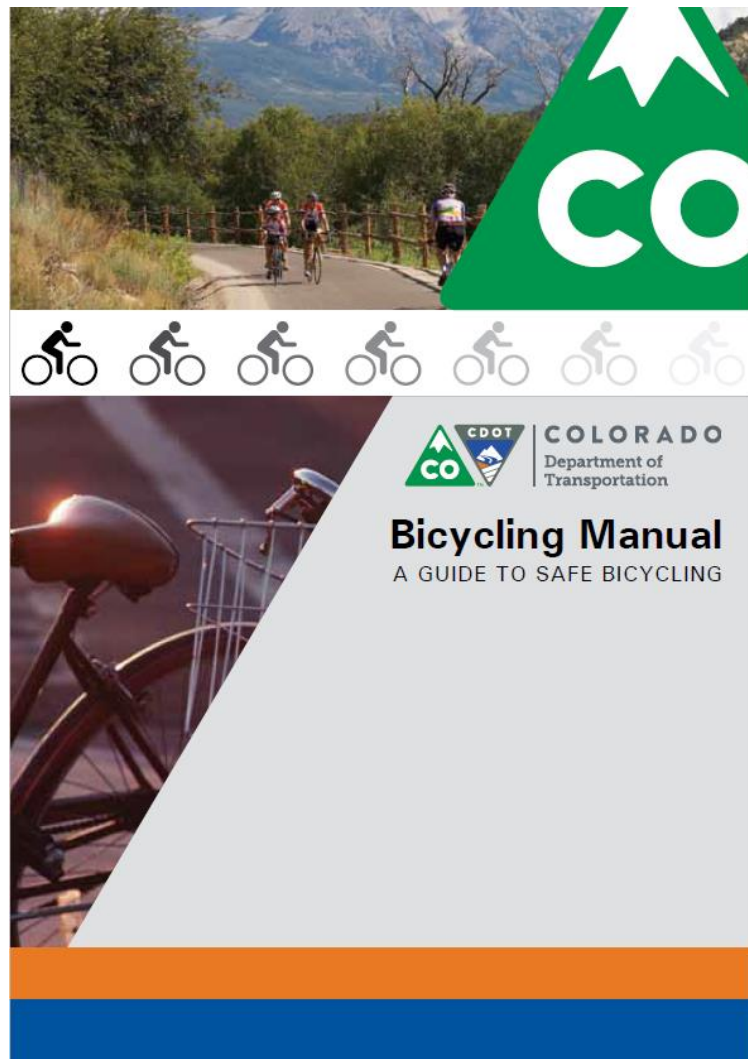


- New language related to the use of bike lanes
 - Drivers yield right-of-way to authorized bike lane users
 - No stopping, standing, parking in a bike lane
 - Exceptions to include bikes, electrical assisted bicycles, and electric scooters
- Existing City Code provisions updated to be consistent in application to electrical assisted bicycles, electric scooters, EPAMD and human powered vehicles
- Equipment required shall conform to state statutes

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- Creates consistent “rules of the road” for the operation of bicycles, electrical assisted bicycles, electric scooters and EPAMDs.
