Background

Developed in 2015

- Designed to be a collaboration between school districts and the Industry
- Home Builders Institute provided the Curriculum
- Initial funding from a private grant from an individual in the Industry
- HBA & AGC developed the Building Futures
 Fund to help fund the program
- Harrison District 2 opened the first school in Fall 2015

 - \$50 New Commercial
 - \$50 Commercial Remodel/Alterations (over \$20k)

- Managed by the HBA Workforce Development Council Finance Committee








Grant Recipient
