## RESOLUTION NO. -15

## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS AND THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE I-25 / CIMARRON STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

**WHEREAS,** on July 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2014 the City of Colorado Springs ("City") and the Colorado Department of Transportation ("CDOT") entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") for funding for roadway and bridge improvements for CDOT's I-25 Cimarron Street Reconstruction Project ("Project"); and

**WHEREAS,** as a requirement of the IGA, the City agreed to contribute a \$5,000,000.00 match contribution through Pikes Peak Rural Transportation Authority ("PPRTA") funds for the Project; and

**WHEREAS,** Resolution No. 57-14 requires that the City Council approve any increase in the City's PPRTA funding match commitment for the Project, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to approve the amendment to the IGA to increase the City's PPRTA funding match commitment for the Project by \$2,050,000.00, for a total project commitment of \$7,050,000.00.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. The "Contract Amendment" for Project # 19030, IM 0252-4 for the I-25 / Cimarron Street Reconstruction Project, attached and made a part of this resolution is hereby approved and authorizes an additional City match commitment of \$2,050,00.00 to be paid from PPRTA funds.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute, deliver and administer the IGA on behalf of the City, and the City Clerk is directed to attest the Mayor's signature and affix the seal of the City on the Contract Amendment.

Section 3. Any future amendments to the IGA increasing the City's PPRTA funding match commitment amount must be approved by a subsequent City Council Resolution.
