Strategy – Two-Prong Approach

- 1. The Coalition has retained the lobbying firm of Mehlman, Castignetti, Rosen, Bingel and Thomas (MCRBT) in Washington, D.C. to work with the executive and legislative branches.
- 2. The Coalition is developing a federal grant strategy to secure valuable resources for regional priorities (i.e. cyber, innovation, transportation, etc.)

- Established working groups on priority issues for 2016; aging and wellness/prevention health issues, innovation and cyber
- Convened working group that led to establishing the National Cybersecurity Center and continue to access opportunities at the federal level



- Annual trip to Washington, D.C. to work with Colorado delegation and other federal officials on key initiatives (City Council has regularly participated)
- Secured \$19Million in funding for the Emergency Watershed Protection program to allow Waldo Canyon and other areas to implement flood and fire recovery efforts



- Sequestration work with Colorado's Two US Senators, Congressman Lamborn and other congressional members
- Influenced delegation to force United Health Care to repair damage during transition from Tri-Care



- Inspired the federal Economic Development Administration attention to region and conducting follow up action for funding
- Worked with delegation on flood insurance issue
- > Combat Aviation Brigade at Fort Carson
- Work on the AFA flight pattern noise issues



- Helped change Local Contractors Bid Process at the federal level
- Partnered to move widening I-25 north of Colorado Springs
- Met with US Secretary of Transportation about regional needs
