

ORDINANCE NO. 18-\_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 106 (STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING IN CITY PARKS) OF ARTICLE 12 (STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING REGULATIONS) AND SECTION 104 (BICYCLES) OF ARTICLE 27 (PARK TRAFFIC OFFENSES) ALL OF CHAPTER 10 (MOTOR VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO MOTOR VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Section 106 (Stopping, Standing or Parking in City Parks) of Article 12 (Stopping, Standing or Parking Regulations) of Chapter 10 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

10.12.106: STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING IN CITY PARKS:

It shall be unlawful for any person to stop, stand or park a vehicle anywhere within a City park between the hours of ~~eleven o'clock (11:00)~~ **ten o'clock 10:00** P.M. and five o'clock (5:00) A.M., or during the time any park is closed pursuant to section 4.2.103 of this Code; and, no person shall allow, permit or cause a vehicle to remain stopped, standing or parked anywhere within a City park between the hours of ~~eleven o'clock (11:00)~~ **ten o'clock 10:00** P.M. and five o'clock (5:00) A.M.; except that when a permit is issued pursuant to section 4.3.101 of this Code.

Section 2. Section 104 (Bicycles) of Article 27 (Park Traffic Offenses) of Chapter 10 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

10.27.104: BICYCLES:

It shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle within any park on other than a paved or improved dirt vehicular road or path specifically designated for bicycle traffic. A bicyclist shall be permitted to walk a bicycle over any grassy area, ~~wooded~~-trail or on any other area reserved for pedestrian use.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 4. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
