AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 19-87 (2020 APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE) FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE LODGERS & AUTO RENTAL TAX (LART) FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$121,000 FOR FIVE ADDITIONAL PROJECTS AND EVENTS RECOMMENDED BY THE LART CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 19-87 is hereby amended by increasing the expenditure appropriation of the Lodgers & Auto Rental Tax (LART) Fund in the amount of \$121,000 for the following 2020 LART projects and events. The source of funds is the LART available fund balance. The following projects and events were recommended by the LART Citizen Advisory Committee at their November 2019 meeting:

- Challenger Center National Conference \$3,000
- 2020 Pioneer League All-Star Game (Rocky Mtn Vibes) \$15,000
- 2020 Ladies Junior PGA Tournament (Colorado PGA) \$50,000
- VisitCOS Promotional Opportunity \$50,000

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.
