RESOLUTION NO. - 14

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF \$10,000,000 FROM THE MEMORIAL HEALTH SYSTEM ENTERPRISE FUND TO THE COLORADO SPRINGS HEALTH FOUNDATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE HEALTH SYSTEM OPERATING LEASE AND INTEGRATION AND AFFILIATION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 92-12, City Council authorized the formation of the Colorado Springs Health Foundation (the "City Health Foundation"), with the express purpose "to receive, hold and manage in perpetuity all funds and monies received" pursuant to the agreements and transactions approved by City Council and by vote of the citizens of the City of Colorado Springs concerning the lease of the City's Memorial Health System and as set forth in Resolution No. 89-12; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 92-12 City Council directed that all funds and monies received pursuant to the Health System Operating Lease and the Affiliation and Integration Agreement "shall be placed directly into the City Health Foundation"; and

WHEREAS, a lawsuit filed by the City of Colorado Springs against the Public Employees' Retirement Association prevented the immediate placement of funds received from the transaction and agreements with the City Health Foundation; and

WHEREAS, on September 23, 2014 the City and the Public Employees' Retirement Association executed a settlement agreement resolving this litigation; and

WHEREAS, the City Health Foundation has requested a transfer of \$10,000,000 pursuant to Resolution No. 92-12; and

WHEREAS, the current Memorial Health System Enterprise Fund balance Of \$16,100,000 will be sufficient to satisfy any remaining financial obligations resulting from the litigation after the transfer of \$10,000,000 to the City Health Foundation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. The City's Chief Financial Officer is authorized to transfer \$10,000,000 from the Memorial Health System Enterprise Fund to the Colorado Springs Health Foundation in accordance with the Health System Operating
