

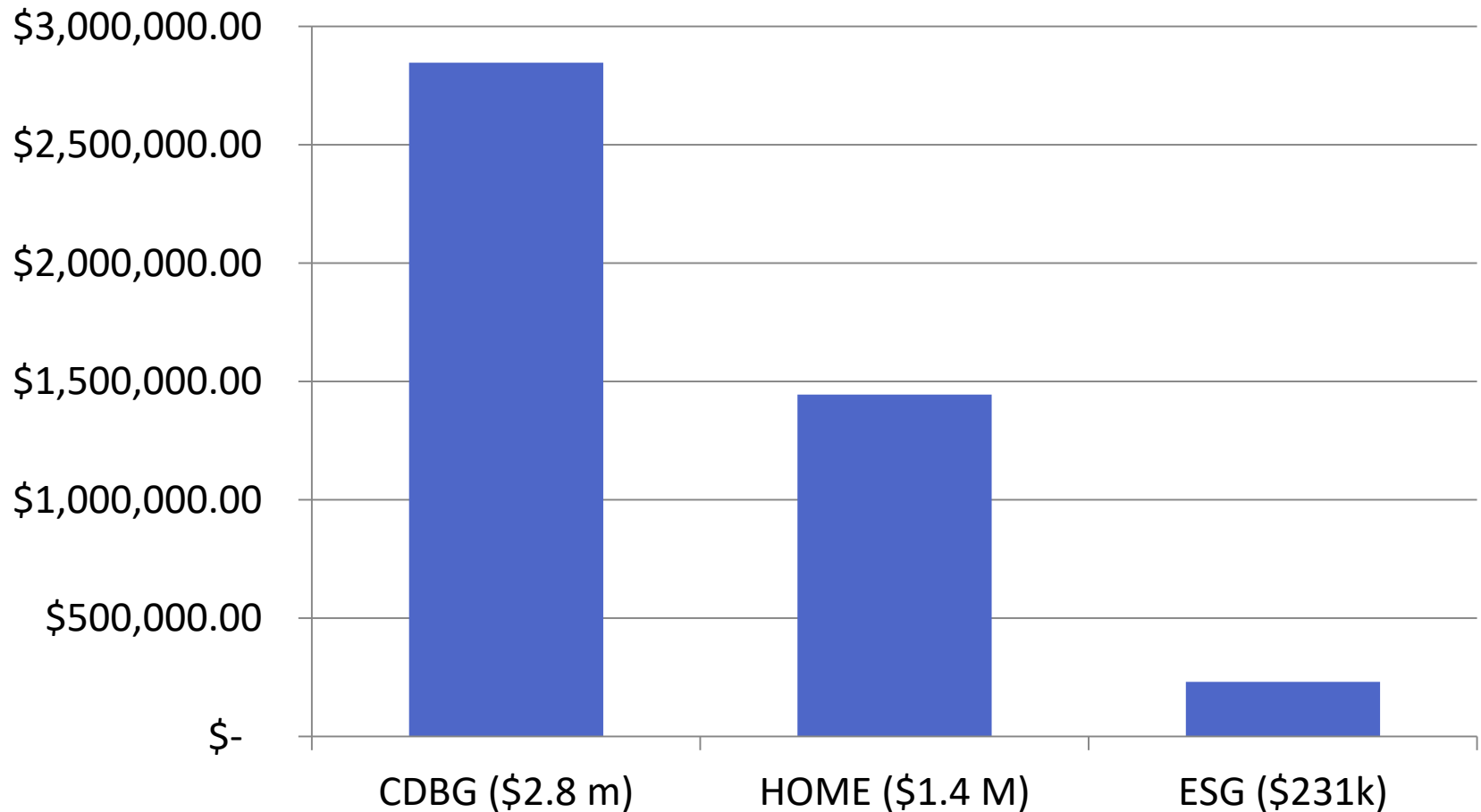

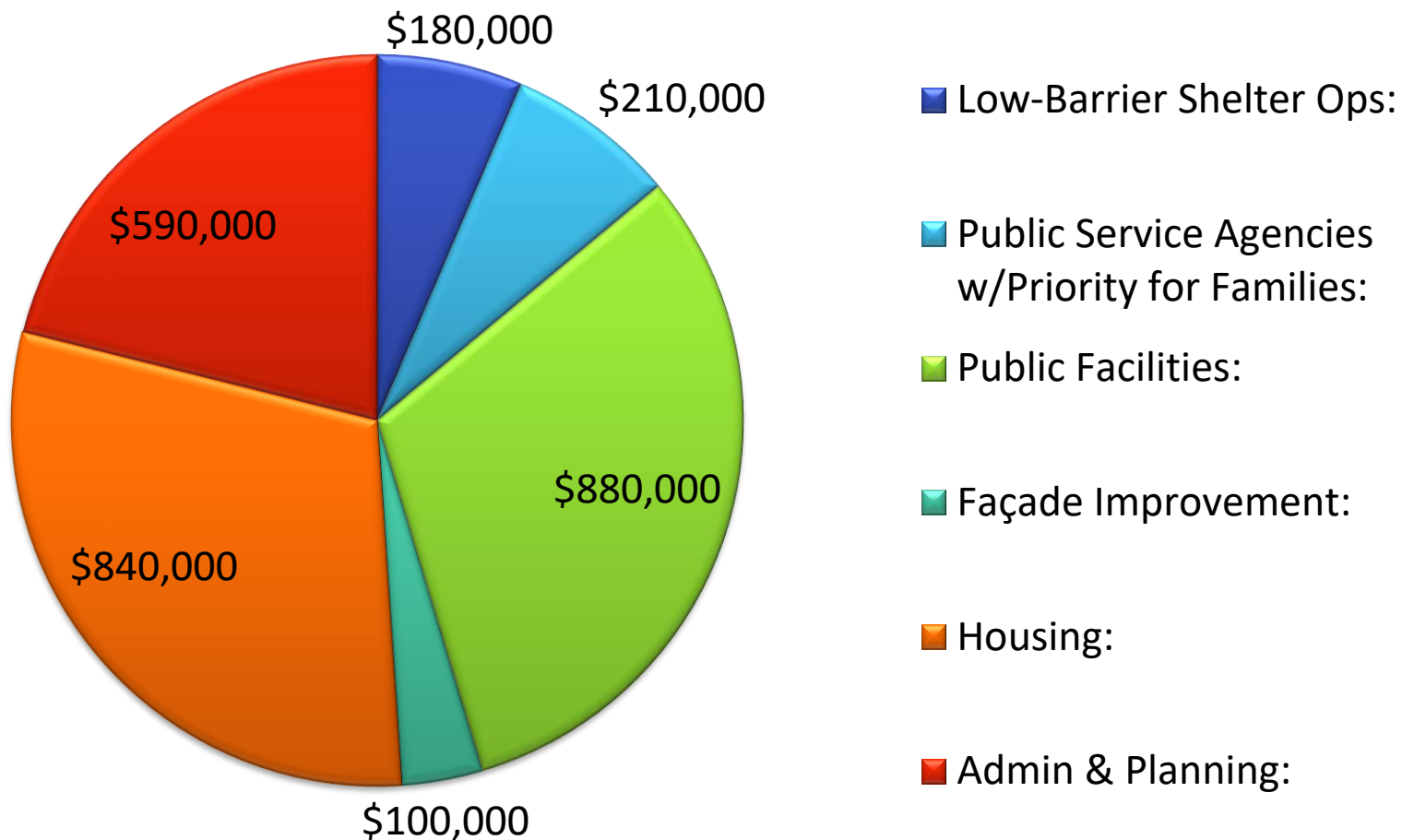

# CDBG Uses



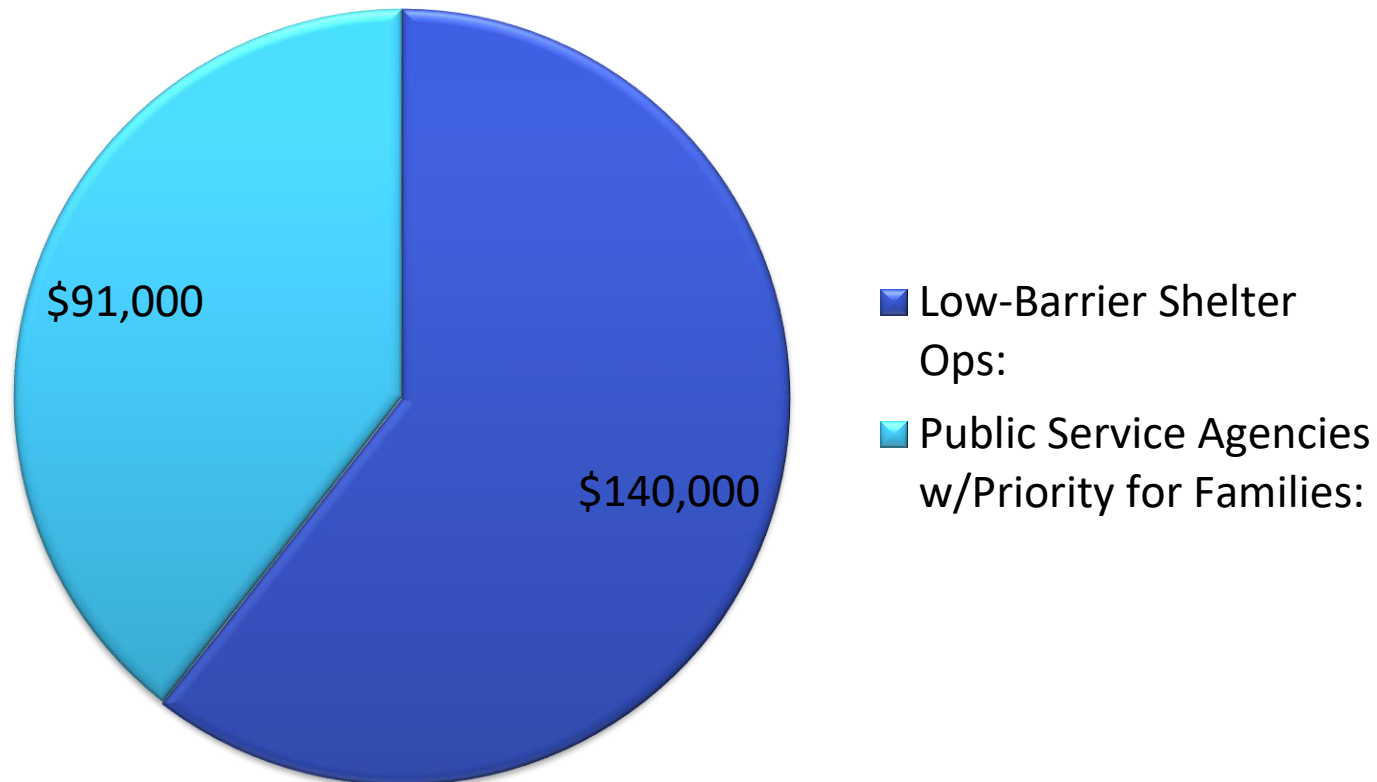
## CDBG Total Available \$2.8 M
