A RESOLUTION OF ACCEPTANCE SUPPORTING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS AND THE STATE BOARD OF THE GREAT OUTDOORS COLORADO TRUST FUND FOR THE HARLAN WOLFE PARK FLOOD RESTORATION AND PARK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Colorado Springs, El Paso County, and many other Front Range cities were significantly impacted by the devastating floods of September 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Cheyenne Creek neighborhood and Harlan Wolfe Park were significantly impacted by the September floods; and

WHEREAS, the City of Colorado Springs supports repairing and enhancing Harlan Wolfe Park through the Harlan Wolfe Park Flood Restoration and Park Project for the benefit of the surrounding neighborhoods and the citizens of Colorado Springs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Colorado Springs Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Department has received a grant from Great Outdoors Colorado in the amount of \$98,521 to fund the Harlan Wolfe Park Flood Restoration and Park Project, subject to the execution of a grant agreement.
