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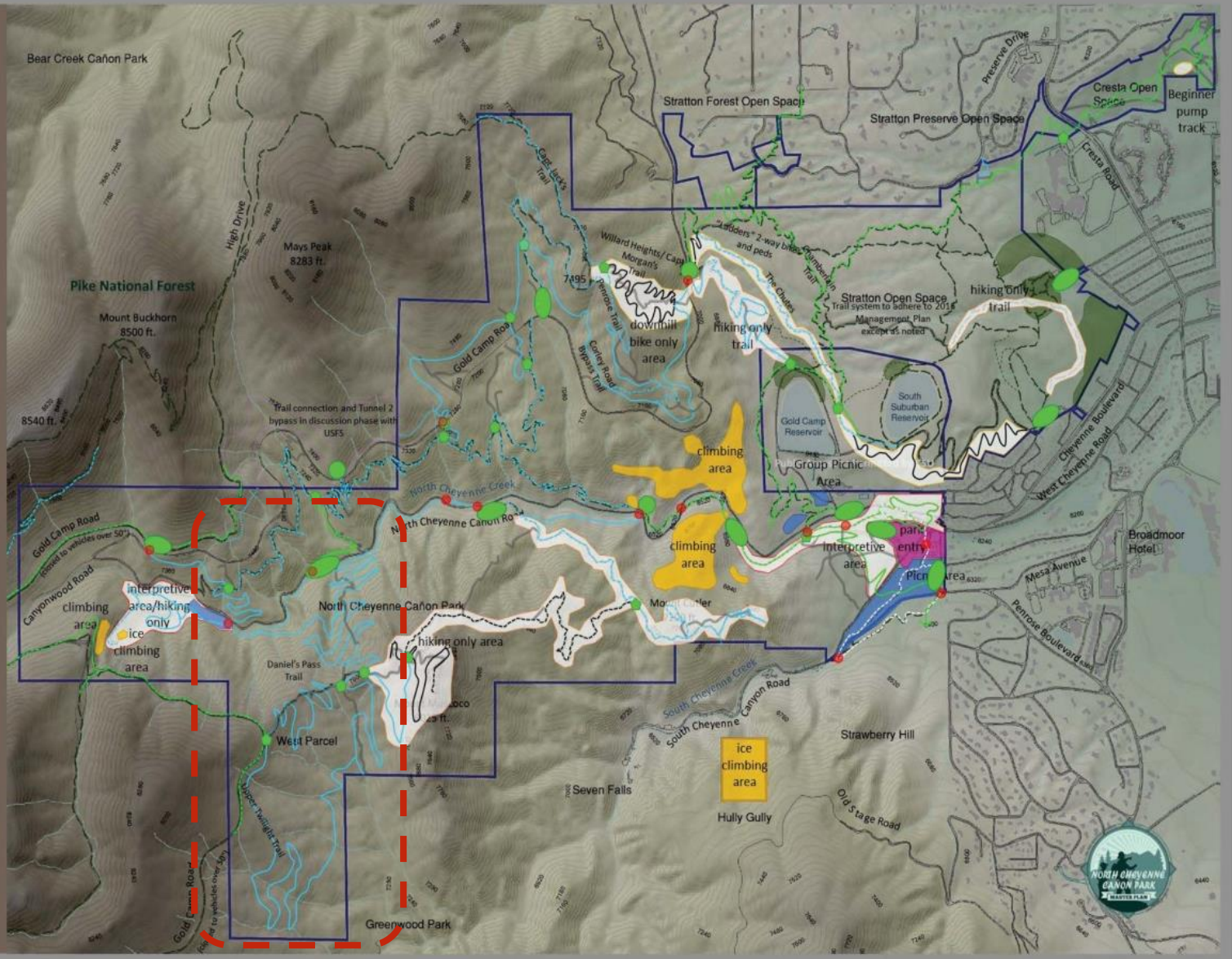

Trailhead Development

- Paved parking lot for 12 cars
- Informational kiosk with trail map
- Trail crossing on N. Cheyenne Cañon Road



Scope of Work



Trail Development

- New 1.9 miles of new sustainable trail construction of the Daniels Pass Trail, connecting N. Cheyenne Cañon Road to Gold Camp Road.
- New 0.5 miles of new sustainable trail construction of the Bruin Inn Connector, connecting Helen Hunt falls Visitor Center and Columbine Trail to the new Daniels Pass Trail.
- Installation of two new pedestrian fiberglass trail bridges over Cheyenne Creek. One for the Daniels Pass Trail, the other for the Bruin Inn Connector.
- Trail closure of unsustainable rogue trails.
