ORDINANCE NO. 19-33

AN ORDINANCE TERMPORARILY WAIVING CERTAIN APPOINTMENT CRITERIA FOR THE FIRE BOARD OF APPEALS

WHEREAS, the Fire Board of Appeals was formed through § 8.3.101 of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended ("City Code"); and

WHEREAS, the Fire Board of Appeals is a board appointed by the City Council and subject to the requirements for appointment as set forth in City Code § 1.2.901, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 18-104, the City Council amended the general requirements for appointments to its boards and commissions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Code § 1.2.901 (C), a term limited member of a Council appointed board or commission may serve for up to ninety (90) days beyond the expiration of a term of appointment; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Code § 1.2.901 (F), unless permitted by the enabling ordinance of a Council appointed board no person shall be appointed unless a resident of the City of Colorado Springs; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Board of Appeals consists of members with a variety of technical expertise that make replacement appointments of members unusually difficult; and

WHEREAS, Fire Department staff has requested for the Fire Board of Appeals a one (1) year exemption from the term limit and residency requirements due to hardship in filling necessary terms to achieve a quorum; and

WHEREAS, the essential health, safety and welfare services provided by the Fire Board of Appeals necessitates a temporary waiver, as set forth below, of specific requirements contained in City Code § 1.2.901.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. The City Council finds that due to the essential role of the Fire

Board of Appeals and its difficulty in making appointments that comply with City

Code § 1.2.901, that the City and its citizens shall suffer a hardship without relief.

The City Council finds that it is necessary and in the best interest Section 2.

of the public health, safety and welfare to grant, and hereby grants, to the Fire

Board of Appeals a one (1) year hardship waiver of the term and residency

requirements contained in City Code § 1.2.901 (C) and (F).

Section 3. The currently serving members of the Fire Board of Appeals

who are term limited, regardless of residency, shall be permitted to serve for one

(1) year beyond the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its

final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 5. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published

by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be

available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
