AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 102 (DEFINITIONS) OF Article 1 (PUBLIC HEALTH AND SANITATION – GENERAL PROVISIONS) OF CHAPTER 6 (NEIGHBORHOOD VITALITY/COMMUNITY HEALTH) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE DEFINITION OF ADMINISTRATOR

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Section 102 (Definitions) of Article 1 (Public Health and Sanitation – General Provisions) of Chapter 6 (Neighborhood Vitality/Community Health) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is amended as follows:

6.1.102: DEFINITIONS:

ADMINISTRATOR; CODE ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATOR: ~~The Chief of Police or the Chief's~~ **The Manager of Community Development or the Manager's** designee responsible for enforcing the health, sanitation and housing ordinances of the City, or the Code Enforcement Administrator's designee.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
