A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 4-14, WITH RESPECT TO THE TERMS OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS AND THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE VAN BUREN SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROJECT

WHEREAS, City Council, by Resolution No. 4-14, approved the authority to execute several Intergovernmental Agreements (IGAs) between the City of Colorado Springs and the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) for various roadway and bridge projects including the Van Buren Safe Routes to School Project (Van Buren SRTS); and

WHEREAS, the approved funding amount for the Van Buren SRTS project IGA through Resolution No. 4-14 was \$305,649.00; and

WHEREAS, the subsequent IGA provided by CDOT for the Van Buren SRTS project includes a reduced funding amount of \$244,399.00; and

WHEREAS, City Council reserved the right to approve by resolution any changes in the funding amounts and project scopes approved by Resolution No. 4-14.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

- Section 1. City Council finds that entering into the Van Buren SRTS IGA (attached hereto as Exhibit A) with CDOT and accepting the grant funding for the Van Buren SRTS project provided by CDOT is in the best interest of the City of Colorado Springs for the health, safety and welfare of its residents.
- Section 2. Pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes § 29-1-203, City Council has the authority to approve the IGA between CDOT and the City of Colorado Springs to ensure receipt of CDOT roadway and bridge project funding.
- Section 3. City Council hereby amends Resolution No. 4-14 to decrease the amount of funding for the Van Buren SRTS project to \$244,399.00.

Section 4. On behalf of the City, the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and administer the attached Van Buren SRTS IGA between CDOT and the City of Colorado Springs for the Van Buren SRTS project with funding in the amount of \$244,399.00.

Section 5. In accord with Resolution 4-14, any amendments to the Van Buren SRTS IGA that would increase or decrease the amount of the anticipated grant or expand or decrease the project scope must be approved by City Council resolution.

Section 6. All other provisions of Resolution 4-14 are hereby ratified and shall remain in full force and effect.
