WHEREAS, we will continue to be good stewards of our taxpayers' hard-earned dollars and use these limited resources for the benefit of our citizens first rather than on the immigration crisis; and

WHEREAS, our City wholeheartedly supports law enforcement, which includes Colorado Springs Police Department, state and federal law enforcement officers that are helping to manage the immigration crisis, while upholding the rule of law; and

WHEREAS, the City supports and welcomes legal immigrants into our community; and

WHEREAS, City Council is committed to continue making the City of Colorado Springs a place where the rule of law is upheld, taxpayer dollars are protected from the immigration crisis, and all law enforcement officers are supported.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
