A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS  
APPROVING A CHANGE TO THE LEGISLATIVE STATUS OF  
ALLISON VALLEY MASTER PLAN FROM OPERATIVE TO  
IMPLEMENTED

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Planning Division staff of the City of Colorado Springs (“City”), has reviewed and analyzed for conformance with the review criteria contained in § 7.5.402 of the City Code, a change to the legislative status of Allison Valley Master Plan from “operative” to “implemented;” and

WHEREAS, the legislative status changes are consistent with the City’s “Comprehensive Plan”; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Code § 7.5.402, at a public hearing the status change has been reviewed and recommended for approval by the City’s Planning Commission.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:**

Section 1. The above and foregoing recitals are incorporated herein by reference and are adopted as findings and determinations of the City Council.

Section 2. City Council finds that the status change substantially conforms to the criteria contained in City Code § 7.5.402 and hereby approves the status change as listed and attached in Exhibit A.

Section 3. This resolution shall be effective upon its approval by City Council.
