AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 203 (APPLICATION FOR LICENSE; BOND AND INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS; SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION) OF PART 2 (EXCAVATIONS) AND AMENDING SECTION 502 (APPLICATION FOR LICENSE; FEE, TERM) OF PART 5 (CONCRETE CONTRACTORS) OF ARTICLE 2 (STREETS AND PUBLIC WAYS) OF CHAPTER 3 (PUBLIC PROPERTY AND PUBLIC WORKS) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO EXCAVATION AND CONCRETE CONTRACTOR LICENSE FEES

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Section 203 (Application for License; Bond and Insurance Requirements; Suspension or Revocation) of Part 2 (Excavations) of Article 3 (Streets and Public Ways) of Chapter 3 (Public Property and Public Works) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

3.3.203: APPLICATION FOR LICENSE; BOND AND INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS; SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION:

A. Requirements: Any person desiring an excavator's license shall apply to the Deputy Licensing Officer in the Office of the City Clerk. The written application shall state the name, address and principal place of business of the applicant. The license shall be issued by the City Clerk upon payment of the license fee and compliance with the provisions of this part. All excavator's licenses issued shall, unless sooner suspended or revoked, expire on June 30 of each year. A license may be renewed no later than thirty (30) days after the expiration upon payment. The City Clerk shall keep a record of all licenses issued.

Section 2. Section 502 (Application for License; Fee, Term) of Part 5 (Concrete Contractors) of Article 3 (Streets and Public Ways) of Chapter 3 (Public Property and Public Works) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

3.3.502: APPLICATION FOR LICENSE; FEE, TERM:

Any person desiring a license shall make application therefor to the City Clerk on a form provided by the City Clerk. The written application shall state the name and address and principal place of business of the applicant. The license shall be issued by the City Clerk upon payment of all application and license fees. All licenses issued under this part shall, unless sooner suspended or revoked, expire on June 30 of each year, and the license may be renewed no later than thirty (30) days after the expiration. The City Clerk shall keep a record of all licenses issued.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by charter.

Section 4. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance shall be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
