AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 1006 (BOARD CREATED; APPOINTMENTS) AND SECTION 1007 (POWER AND DUTIES) OF PART 10 (PUBLIC SAFETY SALES AND USE TAX FUND) OF ARTICLE 6 (CITY FUNDS) OF CHAPTER 1 (ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL, AND FINANCE) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY SALES TAX OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

Section 1006 (Board Created; Appointments) And Section 1007 (Power and Duties) of Part 10 (Public Safety Sales And Use Tax Fund) of Article 6 (City Funds) of Chapter 1 (Administration, Personnel, And Finance) of The Code Of The City Of Colorado Springs 2001, As Amended, are hereby repealed and removed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.
