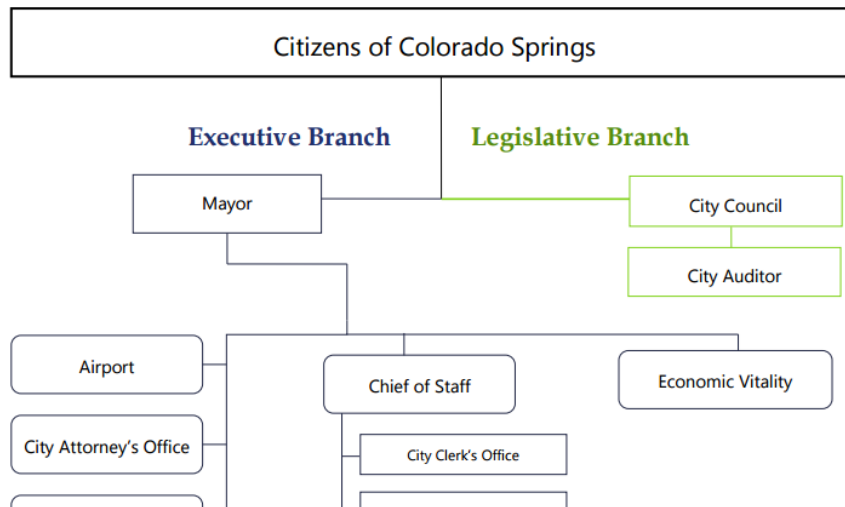

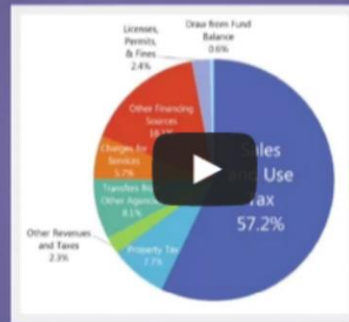

Colorado Springs 2015 Budget Overview

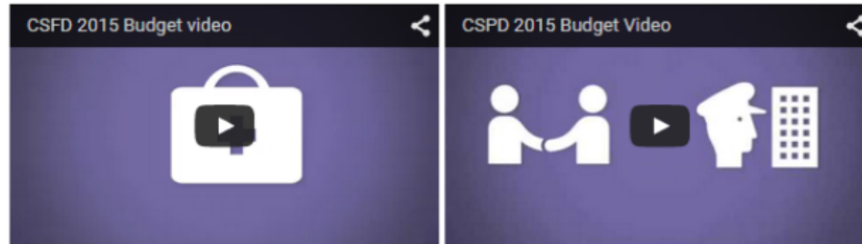

Public Safety consists of the Police Department, Fire Department, and the Office of Emergency Management. These two brief videos will give you more insight into these valuable City functions.

- 1 ▼ Maintain or improve emergency response times across the city
- 2 ▼ Maintain quick police response to calls for service & follow up investigation on crimes
- 4 ▼ Increase high fire risk operation and occupancy inspections
- 3 ▼ Work with citizens to proactively solve neighborhood issues
- 5 ▼ Proactively address traffic safety and school safety
- 6 ▼ Further develop the CARES program with community health partners, making fire-fighting apparatus more readily available for emergency response, rather than medical calls
- 7 ▼ Provide more code enforcement services (weed control, graffiti, housing code violations)
- 8 ▼ Conduct interactive community emergency preparedness events
