 - e.g. changes from prior years; major 2015 activities

Highlights- Downtown Development Authority

- Unique statutory entity
- Approval of budget only
 - To be finalized once AV is fully determined
- 5 mills plus tax increment financing (TIF)
- Significant fund balance carryover
- Significant TIF revenues
- Program/grant funding role



Highlights- BID Mill Levy Changes

- Barnes & Powers North BID
 - Debt service ML to <u>increase</u> from 44.0 to 46.0 (total of 47 with 1.0 operational levy)
 - Necessary to meet debt service obligations
 - Debt service cap is 50.0 mills
- Briargate Center BID
 - Total ML <u>may decrease</u> from 45.0 to 37.0 due to elimination of operational levy of 8.0 mills*
 - *details in next slide



BID Planned Debt Issuance

- First & Main North BID proposes issuance of \$3,000,000 in new debt to repay prior improvements costs
 - Debt will presumably be privately held, as with current debt.
- Briargate Center BID plans to issue about \$1,000,000 in debt for a capital project
 - Including a new traffic signal on Briargate Parkway
 - Request could come as early as late 2014
 - May increase debt service mill levy from 37.00 to 45.00

Boundary Changes

 Greater Downtown BID may include an additional block on S. Tejon St.
