A RESOLUTION OF APPRECIATION DESIGNATING APRIL 10TH THROUGH 16TH, 2016 AS NATIONAL VOLUNTEER WEEK

WHEREAS, April 10th through April 16th is designated as National Volunteer Week to celebrate ordinary people doing extraordinary things to improve communities across the nation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Colorado Springs benefits from thousands of citizen volunteers who support a wide variety of programs including: the Community Advancing Public Safety Program (CAPS); Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Department; and, the Colorado Springs Airport; and

WHEREAS, in the CAPS program 550 volunteers provided over 65,900 hours of civic engagement to advance public safety in 2015; and

WHEREAS, in the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Department, over 5,200 volunteers contributed over 158,000 hours of service to the community in 2015; and


WHEREAS, in the Colorado Springs Airport, over 50 volunteers contributed nearly 4,500 hours of service to the community in 2015; and

WHEREAS, this level of effort, calculated at the national value of volunteerism which is \$25.68 per hour, equaled over \$5.8 million dollars in service that benefits the community.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:


