FEES AND CHARGES – CITY CODE REFERENCE



Referencing City Code Chapter 14 – Municipal Enterprises:

14.2.304: FEES:

Fees established by City Council resolution shall be charged for all grave spaces, opening and closing of graves, disinterments and the overtime services of cemetery employees incidental to burial and any other service or product provided by the cemeteries. All fees charged are to be paid to the Cemetery Manager. (Ord. 93-149; Ord. 01-42)

FEES AND CHARGES PROCESS



Apply a strategy to determine how best to provide services effectively and efficiently

- a) Alignment with organizational purpose – Does the service support the Department’s mission statement?
- b) Financial viability – Is the service self-sustaining or does it have the capacity to be?
- c) Market position – What is the service’s current market position?
- d) Other key provider/competitor coverage – How much competition exists and to what degree?
- e) Application of Department and City Revenue and Fee Policies

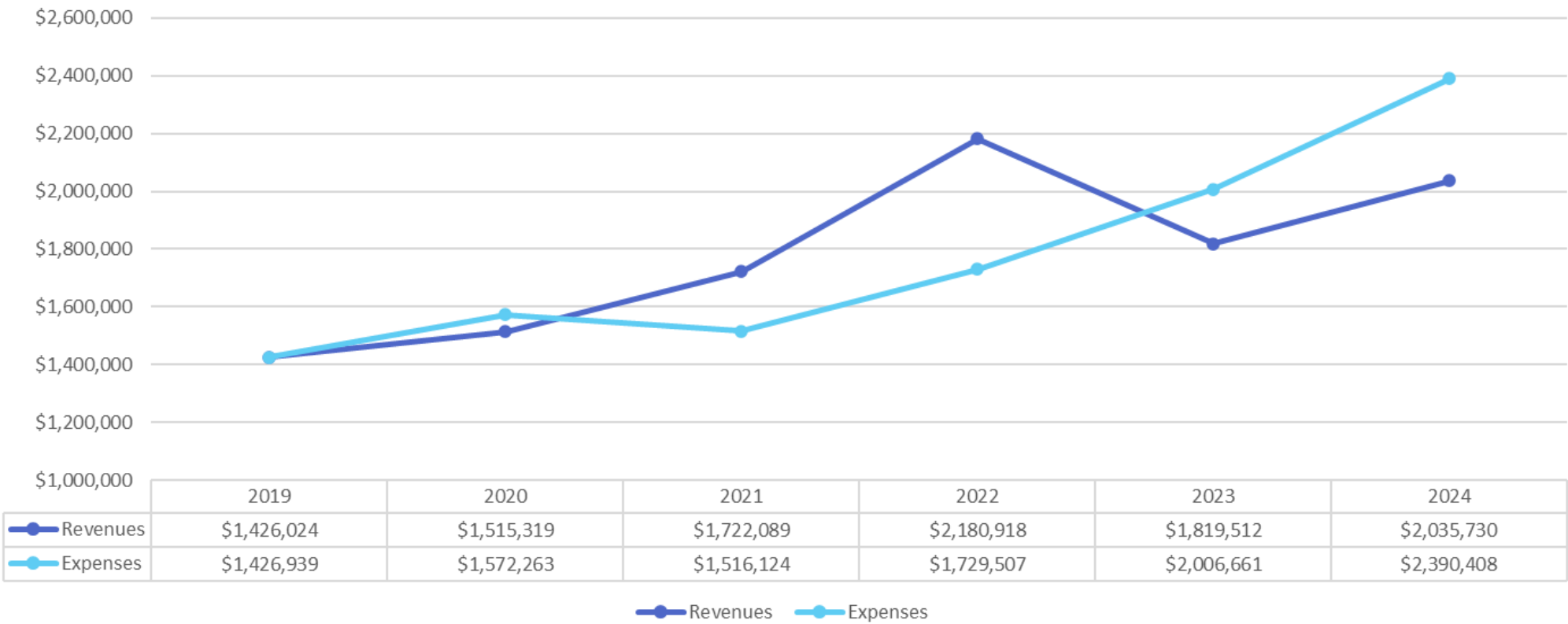
Cemetery Enterprise

NEW FEES



New Fee	2025	2026
Document Fee	N/A	\$100

- Applies to all property contracts
- Covers the cost of producing, printing and mailing deeds
- Standard practice across the industry
- Generates approximately \$50K annually

Proposed fees and charges will be presented at City Council meetings beginning June 23, 2025:

- a) Public input
- b) Fee schedule for review
- c) Final version will continue through the budget process

Important Dates:

- a) June 2nd – Proposed revenue increase to Budget Office
- b) June 12th – Parks Board Action Item
- c) June 23rd – City Council Work Session
- d) July 8th – City Council Regular Session
- e) Oct-Dec – Final Review and approval of budget
