Summary



- New metropolitan districts to serve and provide financing for approved but not-yet-developed Greenways project
 - 172 total acres in districts
 - About 800-1,000 dwelling units
- Consolidated service plan
 - District 1- Commercial
 - District 2- Residential
 - District 3- Residential
- No variances from Special District Policy
- \$31M combined maximum debt authorization
 - \$24M for Districts 1 and 3
 - \$7M for District 2
- \$27.1M in identified costs

Summary- Continued



- Districts could own and maintain up to 48-50 acres
 - Including community park and detention ponds
- Costs to be financed:
 - Roads, roundabouts, medians, water, sewer, detention, park, trails
- Authorized operations and maintenance functions include:
 - Parks and community centers
 - Streetscapes, monumentation public arts etc.
 - Covenant enforcement
 - But not full HOA function




Greenways at Sand Creek

November 2019 Conceptual Lot Layout* & Product Key with Surrounding Zone Districts









Prior to April, 2020 rezoning











