14-22 Electric Cost Adjustment

Purpose

The purpose of this audit was to evaluate whether Colorado Springs Utilities prepared the Electric Cost Adjustment (ECA) in accordance with the approved tariffs. The methodology was compared to prior filings for consistency, and calculations were tested for accuracy.

Conclusion

Based on our review of the calculations and related background information, we conclude that the ECA was calculated in accordance with the approved tariff.

The last ECA adjustment was effective July 11, 2014, resulting in a charge of \$.0074 per unit.

The under-collected balance at July 31, 2014, was (\$1.01) million. Colorado Springs Utilities proposes in this filing to reduce the ECA charge of \$.0074 to \$.0007 per unit effective September 12, 2014. The proposed rate is less than the .0013 charge in effect prior to the May 2014 Drake unit repair outage.

Colorado Springs Utilities provides the Utilities Board with a status on the ECA actual and projected balances monthly. This business practice ensures that policymakers will be aware of changes in costs and forecasts.
