<p><b>Vehicles &amp; Equipment:</b></p> <p>Liability: (Expand covered individuals, includes scope of employment language)</p> <p>Liability for property damage to Metro VNI vehicle, in the event a vehicle is damaged as a result of an act or omission by a member of the Metro VNI sworn or civilian staff during the course and scope of employment, the at-fault driver's home agency will be responsible for vehicle repairs in an amount not to exceed five thousand dollars per vehicle.</p> <p>Repair Costs: (Specifies if Executive Board decides not to approve payment at-fault driver agency is responsible)</p> <p>Vehicle damages over five thousand dollars (\$5,000) will be presented to the Executive Board for consideration of payment. If payment for the repair or replacement of the vehicle is not approved by the Executive Board the home agency of the at-fault driver is responsible for the repair or replacement of the vehicle.</p> <p>Responsibility when 3<sup>rd</sup> Party at-fault:</p> <p>In the event a vehicle is damaged as a result of an act or omission by a third party, the agency which owns the vehicle is responsible for pursuit of legal remedy against the third party and/or for repair and/or replacement of the vehicle</p> <p>Add language on maintenance and repair of City owned vehicles through City Fleet.</p> <p>Clarifies role of Division Equipment Coordinator.</p>	<p><b>Vehicles &amp; Equipment:</b></p> <p>Liability: (limited language on vehicle accidents)</p> <p>In the event a vehicle is damaged, the at fault driver's home agency will be responsible for vehicle repairs in an amount not to exceed five thousand dollars per vehicle.</p> <p>Repair Costs:</p> <p>Damages over five thousand dollars will be presented to the SIF Board for consideration of payment.</p> <p>Responsibility when 3<sup>rd</sup> Party at-fault No Language</p>

<p><b>Funding:</b></p> <p>Annual budget process</p> <p><b>Additional Language</b>  Specifies that agency that receives Federal Equitable sharing <b>shall</b> manage own funds (necessary after DOJ compliance review).</p> <p>State Public Nuisance/Contraband Forfeiture Act citations and requirements added to IGA.</p> <p>Clarifies role of Asset Forfeiture Specialist tracking position (necessary to comply with new state transparency laws on forfeitures.)</p>	<p><b>Funding:</b></p> <p>Annual budget process language</p>
<p><b>Reporting Requirements</b></p> <p>State requirements have changed with passage of HB 1313 which requires additional transparency reporting into newly created State database.</p> <p>Added reference to Federal Policy Directive 17-1 – provides language on federal adoptions</p> <p>Specifies that Equitable Sharing Agreements will be submitted by each agency that receives or expends federal sharing funding from DOJ</p>	<p><b>Reporting Requirements</b></p> <p>None in MOU</p>
<p><b>Creates Metro VNI Executive Board</b></p> <p>Cleans up ambiguity between Special Investigations Fund Executive Board and VNI Executive Board.</p> <p>Going forward will be only be VNI Executive Board</p> <p>At each Board Exec Board will discuss:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Operation briefing</li> <li>2. Spending decisions over State seized funds</li> <li>3.
