

ORDINANCE NO. 21-_____

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING JACQUELINE ROWLAND AS
CITY AUDITOR AND PRESCRIBING HER DUTIES,
COMPENSATION, AND TENURE IN OFFICE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. Jacqueline Rowland is hereby appointed as City Auditor for the City of Colorado Springs by its City Council, effective as of January 12, 2021 and pursuant to City Charter § 3-10(e), following proper recorded vote by roll call.

Section 2. As City Auditor, Jacqueline Rowland, on behalf of the City and all its enterprises, including Colorado Springs Utilities, shall fulfill all of the powers and duties of that office as set forth in the City Charter and City Code, including City Code § 1.2.701, *et seq.*

Section 3. In accordance with City Charter § 3-10(e) and City Code § 1.2.203, the annual salary of the City Auditor is set at \$177,841, together with applicable benefits, effective January 12, 2021.

Section 4. This ordinance supersedes all prior ordinances to the extent such are inconsistent herewith, including Ordinance No. 19-96.

Section 5. The City Auditor shall serve at the will of the City Council.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by charter.

Section 7. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance shall be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
