I have been licensed in Colorado for 12 years. 4 years at this address. My husband and I have 8 kids. 4 children are over 18 and no longer live at home. We have 4 younger children 2 that are 16 years and old and do not attend my child care. The other 2 are 10 year old twins and yes they count on my licenses and attend as my plus 2 for school agers.

An experienced license is a license that would allow me to change up the ages of the kids I have in care and allow me one more child. A total of 9 kids VS 6 plus 2 (8). I operate all year for working parents. Preschool is Sep to May then it is review curriculum June to Aug.

Space needed for children indoors is 35 square feet of floor space per child and for outdoor it is 75 square feet per child.

I will handle the drop offs and pick ups the same way we always have. Parents all come at different times because of their work schedules. They pull up in front of my house or in my driveway drop off then leave. Pick up is the same way all at different times. I have 3 families at this time so 3 cars that pick up and drop off. All of my parents are informed about where to park and not to park in front of other homes, driveways, or mail boxes. We are also a corner house so there is room on the side of the house if needed but, we have never needed that space.

We have a 6 foot fence around our playground area to reduce noise. We limit our outside time to 30-45 mins 2 times a day.

As far as parking I have a Jeep and a truck parked in the front driveway of the house. We have a breeze driveway beside the regular driveway and there is a gold car (teen car) and a travel trailer. Missing from this photo is our yellow F150 that parks next to the trailer, it is in the shop at the moment.
