

**ISSUES FOR DECISION**  
**2017 RATE CASES HEARING**  
**OCTOBER 25, 2016**

**Electric Service:**

1. Is an increase to the non-fuel revenues of \$10.1 million appropriate for the 2017 rate case test-year period?
2. Should rates and tariffs for the following Electric Service Rate Schedules be revised as proposed:
  - a) Residential Service
  - b) Commercial Service – General – E2C
  - c) Commercial Service – General – ETC
  - d) Industrial Service – Time-of-Day Transmission Voltage
  - e) Industrial Service – Time-of-Day 1,000 KWh/Day Minimum
  - f) Industrial Service – Time-of-Day 500 KW/Day Minimum
  - g) Industrial Service – Time-of-Day 4,000 KW/Day Minimum
  - h) Contract Service – Street Lighting
  - i) Contract Service – ECD
  - j) Contract Service – Wheeling – ECW
  - k) Totalization Service
  - l) Renewable Energy Net Metering
  - m) Enhanced Power Service
  - n) Community Solar Garden Bill Credit (Pilot Program)
  - o) Community Solar Garden Program
3. Should Utilities remove the optional Kilowatcher program from the Industrial Service – Time-of-Day Service 1,000 kWh/Day Minimum, Industrial Service – Time-of-Day Service 500 kW Minimum, Industrial Service - Time-of-Day Service 4,000 kW Minimum, and Contract Service?
4. Should Utilities increase the Reserved Capacity Charge incurred by Enhanced Power Customers which will complete a five year phase in program to bring this rate to full cost?
5. Should Utilities remove of the Wind Power tariff due to expiration of the program?

## **Water Service:**

1. Is an increase to the Water Service revenues of \$11.3 million appropriate for the 2017 rate case test-year period?
2. Should rates and tariffs for the following Water Service Rate Schedules be revised as proposed:
  - a) Residential Service – Inside City Limits
  - b) Nonresidential Service – Inside City Limits
  - c) Residential Service – Outside City Limits
  - d) Nonresidential Service – Outside City Limits
  - e) Contract Service
  - f) Temporary Service – Hydrant Use
  - g) Miscellaneous Service – Augmentation
  - h) Miscellaneous Service – Nonpotable
  - i) Contract Service – Nonpotable
  - j) Large Non-seasonal Service

## **Wastewater Service:**

1. Should rates and tariffs for the following Wastewater Service Rate Schedules be revised as proposed:
  - a) Residential Service – Inside City Limits
  - b) Nonresidential Service – Inside City Limits
  - c) Residential Service – Outside City Limits
  - d) Nonresidential Service – Outside City Limits
  - e) Contract Service – Outside City Limits
  - f) Contract Service

## **Utilities Rules and Regulations:**

1. Should Utilities increase the restoration time of customers who have been disconnected from service due to customer controlled activity from a maximum of 12 hours to 24 hours and revise the definition of business hours?
2. Should Utilities increase the amounts collected through contributions in aid of construction in the Electric line extensions and services and Natural Gas mains and services?
3. Should Utilities change the multiplier for all meter sizes greater than four inch to a meter capacity ratio for the Water development charges?
4. Should Utilities change the multiplier for all meter sizes greater than  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch to a meter capacity ratio for the Wastewater development charges?
5. Should Utilities correct an incorrect reference to a section of a City Code within URR Section 39?
