

RESOLUTION NO. 120-21

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN  
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE  
EL PASO COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER AND THE  
CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS REGARDING THE  
CONDUCT AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE NOVEMBER  
2, 2021 COORDINATED ELECTION

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2021 the Colorado Springs City Council adopted Resolution 95-21 indicating the intent of the City of Colorado Springs to participate in the November 2, 2021 coordinated election and designating the same as a special municipal election; and

WHEREAS, on August 10, 2021 and August 24, 2021 the Colorado Springs City Council will vote to refer ballot questions to the November 2, 2021 coordinated election; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk of the City of Colorado Springs has worked with the El Paso County Clerk and Recorder to negotiate the terms of the attached intergovernmental agreement; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes § 1-7-116(2), an intergovernmental agreement is required to govern the parties' respective duties concerning the conduct of the November 2, 2021 Coordinated Election.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS THAT:**

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the intergovernmental agreement between the El Paso County Clerk and Recorder and the City of Colorado Springs regarding the conduct and administration of the November 2, 2021 Coordinated Election ("IGA"), a true copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, effective this 24<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2021.

Section 2. On behalf of the City, the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and administer the attached IGA between the El Paso County Clerk and Recorder and the City of Colorado Springs.
