

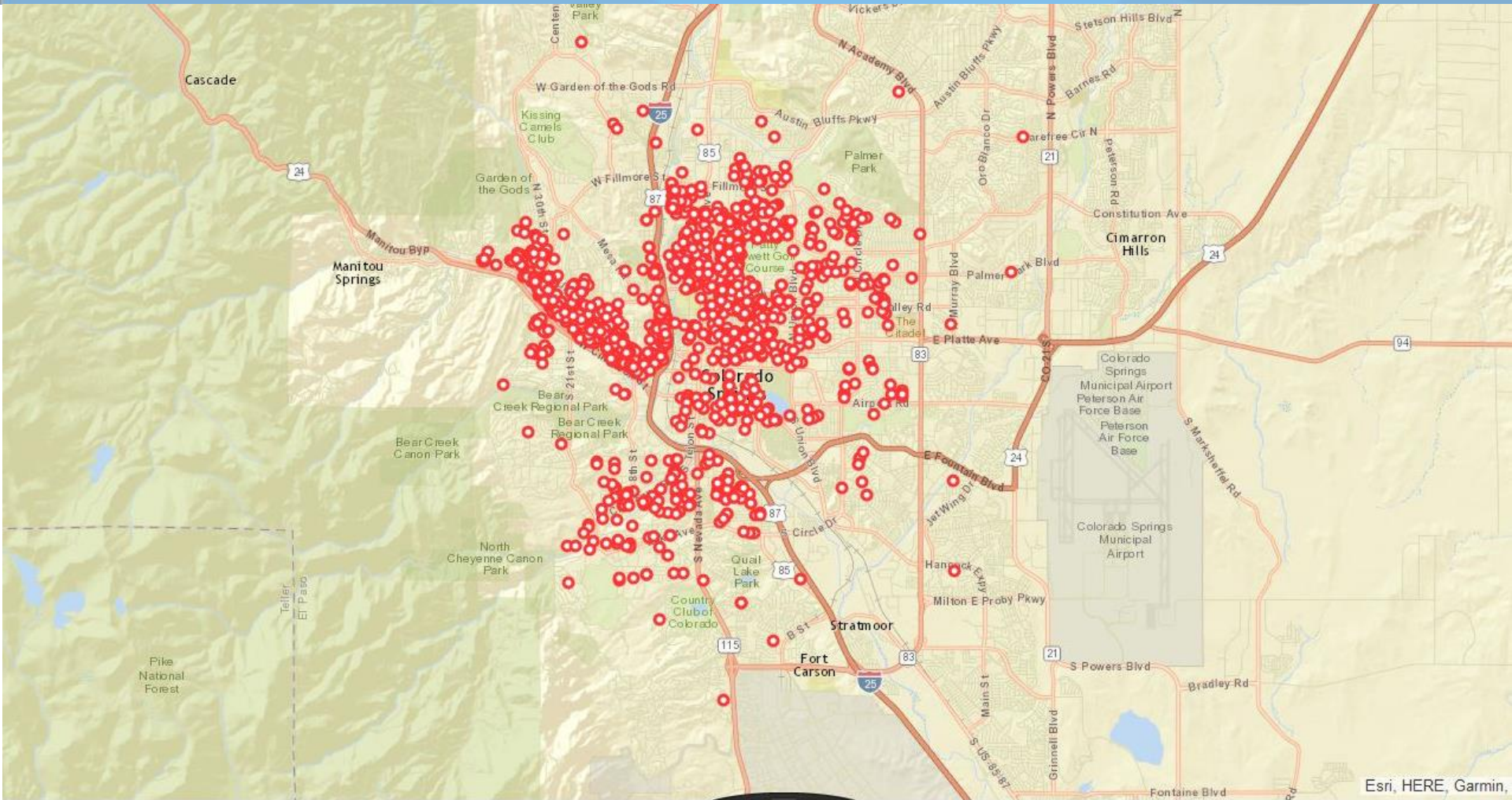

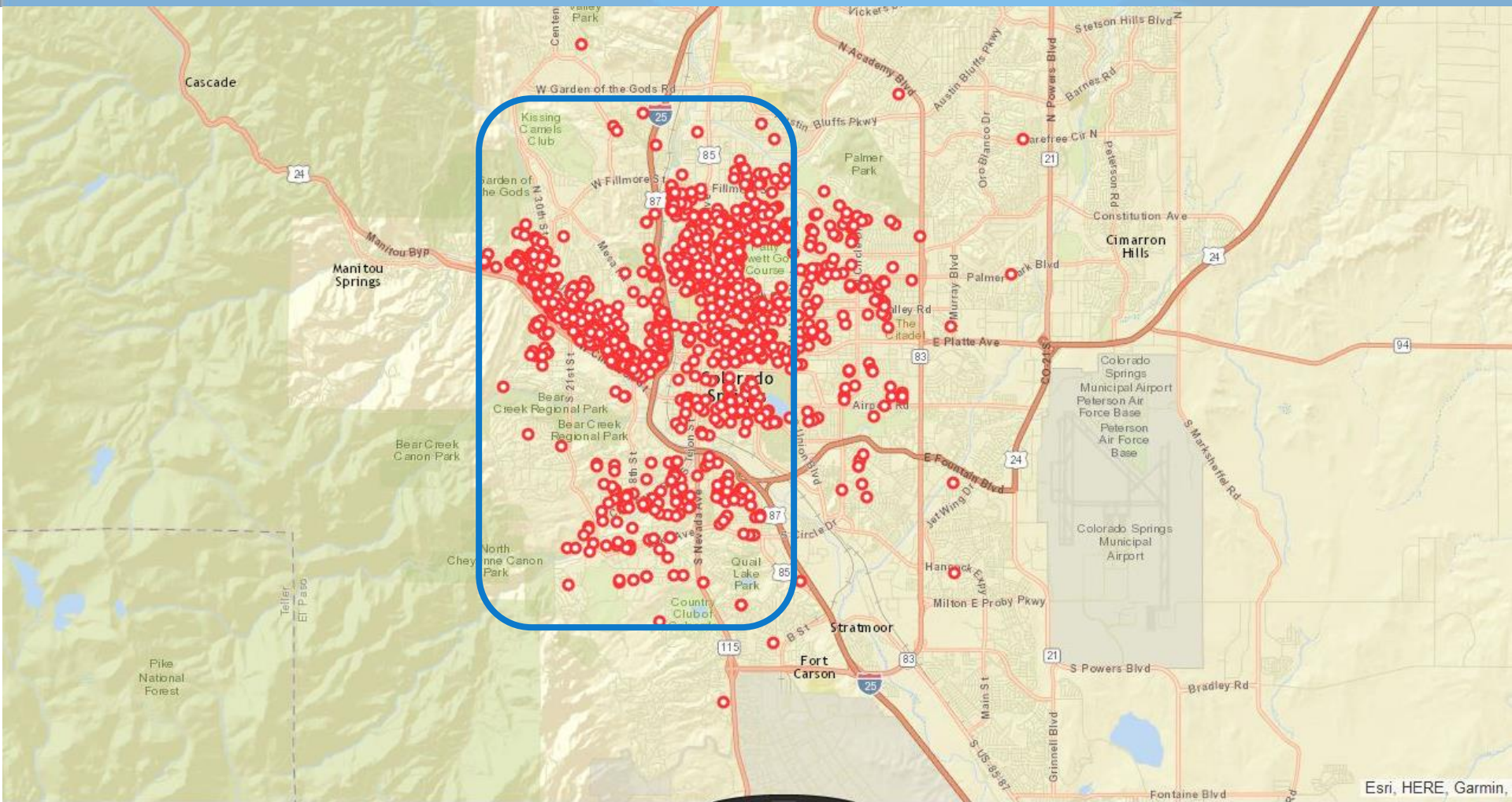


# Call Distribution Following the Storm

## April Snowstorm Statistics:

### Original Numbers:

- Number of citizen requests following the storm: 1,465\*
- Number of tasks created for hangers/broken branches: 558
- Number of tasks created for down limbs/brush piles: 797



\* These numbers only reflect requests from citizens. The actual number of tasks will be higher when the project is complete.

## April Snowstorm Statistics:

### Outstanding Citizen Requests:

- Number of tasks remaining for hangers/broken branches: 104
- Number of tasks remaining for down limbs/brush piles: 59

### Emergency Tree Service Contract:

- Funds spent on contract crews as of June 9, 2017: \$58,000
- Projected cost of contract crews to complete cleanup: \$17,000

**Total Estimated Contractor Cost: \$75,000**
