

ORDINANCE NO. 15-_____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 14-101
(2015 APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE) TO ADOPT THE
BUDGET AND APPROPRIATE MONIES FOR THE SENIOR
PROGRAMS FUND

WHEREAS, on or about August 31, 2015, the Colorado Springs Housing Authority will transfer to the City ownership of the Golf Acres Complex property, including the Colorado Springs Senior Center ("Senior Center"), and the balance of funds previously transferred from the City to the Housing Authority for the purpose of supporting the Golf Acres Complex and Senior Center operations; and

WHEREAS, because the funds being transferred to the City were intended solely for the purpose of supporting the Golf Acres Complex and Senior Center operations, it is desirable to hold those funds in a Senior Programs Fund to be used solely for those purposes; and

WHEREAS, there is a significant public benefit to the continuation of senior programs at the Senior Center to serve the senior population within the community; and

WHEREAS, the proposed budget for the Senior Programs Fund, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, ("Senior Programs Fund Budget") will provide funding for the continuation of senior programs at the Senior Center and for the maintenance of the Golf Acres Complex.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 14-101 is hereby amended by adopting the Senior Programs Fund Budget and appropriating \$115,667 for the Senior Programs Fund.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
