Announcement

Basing scorecard

- **Mission Related (40 points)**
Qualified workforce & proximity to mutually supporting space entities
- **Infrastructure Capacity (30 points)**
Facilities, security, energy resilience, child care
- **Community Support (15 points)**
Professional licensure portability, education, cost of living, spt pgms
- **Costs to Dept of the AF (15 points)**
One-time and recurring; infrastructure & housing allowance
