U.S. Space Command

- Economic impact: 1,400 jobs to our region plus millions to billions in infrastructure if we are selected for the permanent HQ
- We will resume the USSPACECOM advocacy campaign to address the new criteria and position the region for the Pentagon's decision in January 2021



Public relations: earned 21 placements after launch



































U.S. Space Command

- Friday May, 15: the U.S. Air Force announced that U.S. Space Command will remain at its provisional headquarters at Peterson Air Force Base for up to six years
- The U.S. Air Force shared new scoring criteria that will be used in its basing decision.

Basing scorecard

- Mission Related (40 points)
 Qualified workforce & proximity to mutually supporting space entities
- Infrastructure Capacity (30 points)
 Facilities, security, energy resilience, child care
- Community Support (15 points)
 Professional licensure portability, education, cost of living, spt pgms
- Costs to Dept of the AF (15 points)
 One-time and recurring; infrastructure & housing allowance
