RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION PROPOSING CERTAIN CHANGES TO THE NATURAL GAS TARIFFS OF COLORADO SPRINGS UTILITIES

- WHEREAS, Colorado Springs Utilities (Utilities) has determined that no base rate change is required for Natural Gas rates at this time, but has proposed changes to multiple Natural Gas Tariff Sheets; and
- **WHEREAS**, Utilities has prepared projections of costs and revenues in conformance with the language in the Gas Cost Adjustment (GCA) tariff; and
- **WHEREAS**, the GCA rate contains a natural gas fuel cost recovery component and a natural gas capacity cost recovery component; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Gas Cost charge of the Natural Gas Rate Schedules also recovers natural gas fuel costs; and
- WHEREAS, Utilities has proposed, and the City Council finds it prudent, to separate the natural gas fuel recovery component and the natural gas capacity cost recovery component of the GCA; to create a new Gas Capacity Charge; and to combine the GCA natural gas fuel recovery component and the Gas Cost charge of the Natural Gas Rate Schedules; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council finds it prudent that the combined natural gas fuel recovery rate be named the "Gas Cost Adjustment", that it contain all natural gas fuel costs, and that the newly combined rate be set at \$0.1961 per hundred cubic feet (Ccf); and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council finds it prudent that the natural gas capacity cost recovery component of the GCA be named the "Gas Capacity Charge" and that it be set forth on the tariff sheets for each customer class; and
- **WHEREAS**, the changes made to the Gas Cost Adjustment and the Gas Capacity Charge create an overall decrease to the present rates; and
- **WHEREAS**, Utilities has proposed, and the City Council finds it prudent to revise the contract termination rights of the Commercial Service Firm Seasonal Option and the Industrial Service Interruptible Sales; and
- **WHEREAS**, Utilities has proposed, and the City Council finds it prudent to modify qualifications to the Commercial Firm Seasonal Option; and
- **WHEREAS**, Utilities has proposed, and the City Council finds it prudent to revise the nomination times for the Industrial Transportation Service Firm in order to comply with new Federal Energy Regulatory Commission guidelines effective April 1, 2016; and
- **WHEREAS**, Utilities has proposed, and the City Council finds it prudent to remove the Industrial Service Interruptible Sales Daily Index Option; and
- **WHEREAS**, Utilities has proposed and the City Council finds it prudent to remove certain USAFA charges from the Contract Service GINFPRS tariff since the construction projects to which those charges applied are now completed and no further billing is necessary; and

WHEREAS, Utilities has provided public notice of the proposed changes and has complied with the requirements of the City Code for changing its natural gas rates, charges and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the proposed modifications to the natural gas rate schedules and tariffs are just, reasonable, sufficient and not unduly discriminatory and allow Utilities to collect revenues that enable Utilities to continue to operate in the best interest of all of its Customers; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Gas Cost Adjustment rate and Gas Capacity Charges shall be effective January 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, specific rates, policy changes, and changes to any terms and conditions of service are set out in the attached tariffs for adoption with the final City Council Decision and Order in this case.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. That Colorado Springs Utilities Tariff, City Council Volume No. 5, Natural Gas Rate Schedules shall be revised as follows:
