AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 18-118 (2019 APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE) FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE LODGERS & AUTO RENTAL TAX (LART) FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$154,652 FOR THREE ADDITIONAL PROJECTS AND EVENTS RECOMMENDED BY THE LART CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 18-118 is hereby amended by increasing the expenditure appropriation of the Lodgers & Auto Rental Tax (LART) Fund in the amount of \$154,652 for the following 2019 LART projects and events. The source of funds is the LART available fund balance. The following projects and events were recommended by the LART Citizen Advisory Committee at their October and November meetings:

- Colorado Springs July 4 Summer Symphony \$38,771
 - IAFF Fallen Firefighter Memorial (payable to CSFD) \$15,881
 - Exponential Impact \$100,000
- \$154,652

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adoption and publication as provided by Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance shall be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the City Clerk.
